Power

- 10MW utility power (2N)

- Two feeders with diverse routes from adjacent substation

Cooling

- Water connection of 25 m3/hr (with back-up supply for at least 24 hours)

- Fully automated building management system providing control, monitoring and alarm of critical building functions
- WonderWare monitoring for electrical systems coming soon
- Leak detection monitoring

Security

- Security guards on-site 24x7x365
- Closed circuit video cameras provide extensive coverage of interior and exterior building areas
- Outer perimeter security fencing
- Single entry point with gated access
- Multi-factor authentication for access

Sustainability

- Utilizing renewable sourced power
- Dedicated electric vehicle (EV) charging spots available on-site
- Water-side economizers provide free cooling during low temperature ambient conditions
- A district heating solution in place. QTS Groningen feeds the city of Groningen's heating system, and in return receives cooling.
